<p>Projects can include the analysis of the quality of medical care, including the procedures used for diagnosis, treatment, care provision, patient profiling and the resulting outcomes.</p>	<p>Projects can include support for updating guidelines focused on identifying and sharing the most effective and efficient ways of working to enhance patient care. The aim of a best practice sharing initiative should be to promote excellence by sharing knowledge and experiences that have led to an improved standard of care provided within an organization.</p>
 <p>Community outreach, education and engagement programs</p>	 <p>Frameworks to improve monitoring of patient-reported outcome measures</p>
<p>Projects can include those aimed at connecting patients and the broader community to promote health/well-being and involve patients in their own health care. Projects can be designed to build relationships, increase awareness, and encourage active participation in health-related activities.</p>	<p>Projects can include those that review current “patient-reported outcome measures” and determine how best to improve the monitoring of outcomes, to enhance patient’s health and well-being when engaging with an organisation and service.</p>
 <p>Infrastructure for better diagnosis or detection of disease</p>	 <p>Patient support programs and tools</p>
<p>Projects can include the development of pathways or services designed to improve the ability to identify diseases accurately and promptly to enhance overall patient care.</p>	<p>Projects can include programs and tools offered by a service or organization to help patients manage their medical condition(s) and navigate the healthcare system more effectively, to improve the overall patient experience when engaging with healthcare services.</p>
 <p>Access to care and patient pathways</p>	 <p>Other</p>
